COURSE OVERVIEW

This course offers students the opportunity to complete 16+ modules of pre-Apprenticeship Building & Construction (Carpentry).

It combines accredited VET curriculum and credit of VCE units 1, 2, 3 and 4 or the required VCE-VM VET hours while pursuing an interest in the Building industry.

ENROLMENT

Students must have successfully completed a minimum of Year 9. Selection may be based on application and interview.
